

Parish Catechetical Leaders (PCL) Formation Program

This **three-part** Certification Formation program is provided by the Diocese of Fall River to promote the mission of Faith Formation. The goal is to encourage Parish Catechetical Leaders to strengthen their theological awareness as well as enhance their professional development and spirituality. The Office of Faith Formation defines PCLs as *any person responsible for* the faith formation of children, teens and/or adults in the parish. All Parish Catechetical Leaders are invited and encouraged to participate. The program is the effort of the Office of Faith Formation and the University of Notre Dame's Satellite Theology Program (STEP Online).

Cost: \$80 per course

The three parts include: (1) Knowledge of Theology; (2) Professional Development; and (3) Spirituality

Upon completion of this program, participants will receive certification as a PCL for the Diocese of Fall River.

Part One: Knowledge of Theology

There are <u>two options</u> for completing Part One: (1) Hold a Degree in Theology or Religious Studies from a Catholic Institution; **OR** (2) Completion of the Notre Dame STEP On-line Theology Program

If option two is selected, the following seven courses provided by Notre Dame STEP are required:

~Introduction to the Old Testament: The Pentateuch ~Introduction to the New Testament

~Doctrine of Salvation in Jesus Christ ~Liturgy: A Guide for the Perplexed

~The Christian Conscience and Ethical Dilemmas ~Eucharist: Source & Summit of the Christian Life

(Not a ND Step Course, Offered by Office of Faith Formation)
